## LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

HIGHER EDUCATION LEGISLATION

The FAFSA Simplification Act of 2019 introduced October 22 .2019 (S.2667, H.R.1075) would amend the Federal Pell Grant program to make application easier by reducing the number of questions to 30 or less on the application form. Additionally there are several other bills which address college student aid. The Protect the GI Bill Act (H.R. 4625) passed the House November 12, 2019.
