LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

House Votes to Establish Smithsonian Women's History

The House of Representatives voted to build a women's history museum on the National Mall. "Women have been left out of the telling of the nation's history. This is about giving women, all women our rightful place in history," said Rep. Carolyn Maloney, who noted the lack of national landmarks or textbook entries dedicated to women. The measure would establish a women's history museum within the Smithsonian Institution and make steps toward the construction of a facility.

January Meeting

We had a great January meeting. Our theme for the meeting was Anywhere is Home, the same as the state theme. We focused on educational around the world. First, Bonnie Dalton shared her experiences from an art trip to France, which will enhance her art classes. Then, Dr. Anthony Maxwell talked to us about literacy initiatives in Middlesboro, KY.
