LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Teachers will see a pay increase

Lawmakers approved a 2% increase to the funding school districts receive for teacher salaries — to a tune of almost \$43 million. But teachers might not see an increase on their paychecks right away and Democrats argue the amount in practice will not equal the money the governor has promised.

Lee committed to including a 4% increase in the fiscal year 2022 budget.
