

the weather begins to change and growth new is spouting, i am so glad that our chapter is sprouting and growing also. I am looking forward to the induction meeting.


I hope you have committed to go to state convention. It is always refreshing for me to just get away. I enjoy seeing old DKG friends and meeting new ones.
