We can make plans and answer any questions about convention at brunch on the 24th.

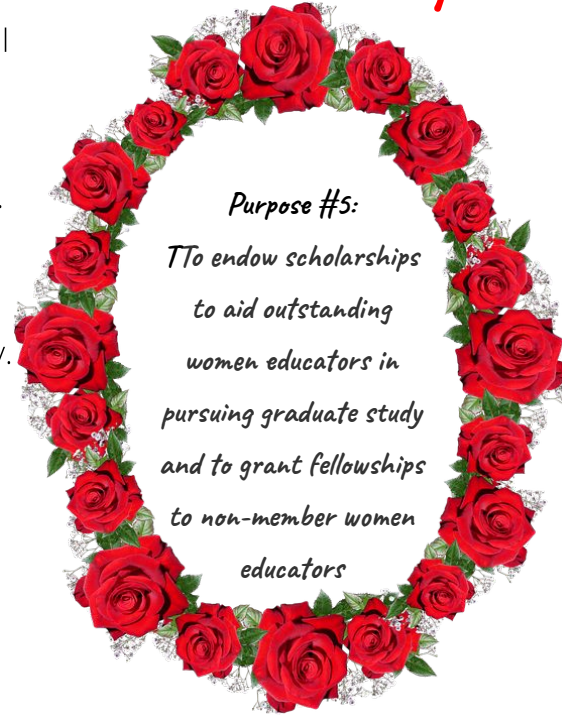

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

SMITHSONIAN WOMEN'S HISTORY MUSEUM

For twenty years DKG's U.S. Forum has supported efforts to have a women's history museum in Washington, DC. It looks closer to becoming a reality with two bills introduced in Congress on March 28 and 29 of this year which would make a Women's Museum part of the Smithsonian Institution's complex of museums. Both the Senate bill (S.959) and the House bill (H.R.1980) have been referred to committee. Currently the museum exists only online at
