

# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE Strengthening CTE

On July 26, the Strengthening Career and Technical Education (CTE) for the 21st Century Act (H.R.2353) was sent to the President to be signed into law. This piece of legislation provides for grants to create "CTE concentrators" and "CTE

participants" and defines these terms. The bill also authorizes that funds to states for 2018-20 shall not be less than what was allocated in 1998. The bill is reauthorized through 2023. For more specific information on the content of this bill go here.
