Revising Teacher Evaluation Criteria

A new law requires greater consideration of student achievement in teacher evaluations. The legislation lowers the teacher observation component of the evaluation from 50% to 40% and increases the student achievement component from 15% to 25% to more adequately measure the proficiency of students.
